



K-6 Classroom Teacher

Classroom teachers at Northcross Christian School will have a passion for teaching and meeting the wellbeing and spiritual needs of the students in their care. They will be suitably qualified educators who are committed to shaping students through outstanding educational experiences and authentic care. They will be involved in all aspects of the responsibilities associated with teaching a class of students. This role involves interacting with families and undertaking administrative duties. Classroom teachers will report to their relevant Stage Coordinator.

- ♦ Qualified to teach, program for and assess K-6 students in NSW
- ♦ Passionate about engaging in evidence-based pedagogy that includes developing critical thinking and problem-solving skills in students
- ♦ Capacity to deliver differentiated programs to meet the needs of all students
- ♦ Confident in the use of ILT in the classroom and for administrative purposes
- ♦ Ability to create an environment of Christian care and support based on Biblical principles

- ♦ Administrative and organisational skills
- ♦ Ability to work as part of a team

- ♦ Ability to demonstrate initiative and be flexible
- ♦ Commitment to their own professional development

- j. preparing class contributions for school assemblies or concerts
- k. attendance and participation at out of hours school events, as directed by the Principal

- ♦ Be actively involved in curriculum development across the school
- ♦ Work collaboratively the Learning Support team to identify, assess, adjust, plan and deliver effective teaching programs and interventions for identified students

Students:

- ◆ Provide pastoral care for students and ensure their physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual needs are met
- ◆ Work collaboratively with the Wellbeing team to monitor the wellbeing of all students in their care
- ◆ Ensure student record files are kept up to date
- ◆ Manage, reward and discipline students according to school policies and in collaboration with the relevant Stage Coordinator

General Duties:

- ◆ Regularly read, respond to and action emails from staff and parents
- ◆ Attend weekly Staff Meetings and be actively involved in professional development activities
- ◆ Actively contribute as a member of an allocated KLA team
- ◆ Contribute to the School News Hub
- ◆ Accept additional responsibilities, as requested by the Senior Executive e.g. extracurricular or events-based responsibilities
- ◆ Regularly attend and contribute to school community events, as required
- ◆ Facilitate and encourage parent involvement in the operation of the school
